FACTSHEET EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT ON THE LIFESG APP

The Ministry of Manpower, Workforce Singapore and Government Technology Agency, supported by SkillsFuture Singapore, Employment & Employability Institute (e2i), Tripartite Alliance for Fair and Progressive Employment (TAFEP) and Tripartite Alliance for Dispute Management (TADM) released a series of Employment Support guides on the LifeSG (previously known as Moments of Life) app in June 2020.

This is part of the Smart Nation initiative to provide citizens with access to simpler digital services and information. It was developed based on insights gathered through citizen engagement sessions to identify and better understand users' challenges and needs. More features will be rolled out progressively.

For a start, citizens can refer to the guides to help them make better informed career decisions. The guides cover the following themes across three sections:

- Support for Job Search as a job seekers' guide that provides users with resource information, available support and advice for their job search and upskilling journey.
- Retrenchment Benefits and Measures that provides users with a one-stop guide, to help retrenched individuals navigate and access support and services across the government or employees to understand better if they are to face retrenchment.
- Financial Support for Workers and Self-employed with consolidated government support information and a listing of government agency schemes and COVID-19 relief measures.



Retrenchment benefits and measures


Retrenchment is a form of dismissal from your job. It happens when companies need to reduce their workforce due to redundancy, reorganisation or changes in the industry.

If you're facing retrenchment, you might be eligible for certain things, including:

- · a notice period
- · retrenchment benefits
- · alternatives to retrenchment
- help in finding a new job

Companies with ten or more employees must notify the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) of retrenchments within 5 working days, after they notify their employees.
